UNITED WAY OF CAYUGA COUNTY INITIATIVES

COMMUNITY BUILDING MINI-GRANT

After seeing the success of our covid relief grants, the Mini-Grant program was established. This program provides support for unexpected opportunities, existing programs and services, and advances in professional development. Applications are available on a rolling, year-long basis, and open to any 501(c)(3) nonprofit serving Cayuga County residents.

STUDENT UNITED WAY

Student United Way is a campus-based club led by and for students, with support from its local United Way and guidance from a campus advisor to develop leadership skills, knowledge about critical community issues, and a better understanding of how they can advance the common good. Currently, this pilot program is in Auburn and we hope to start expanding to other districts in 2024.

CASH: FREE TAX PREP SERVICE

Free tax preparation services are available through the CA\$H Program in collaboration with Cayuga Community College who donates space and phonelines. CA\$H (Creating Assets, Savings, and Hope) is an in person model managed by a Site Coordinator and our IR\$ Certified volunteers who prepare and file taxes for community members earning \$60,000 or less.
