COMMUNITY BUILDING MINI-GRANT

After seeing the success of our covid relief grants, the Mini-Grant program was established. This program provides support for unexpected opportunities, existing programs and services, and advances in professional development. Applications are available on a rolling, year-long basis, and open to any 501(c)(3) nonprofit serving Cayuga County residents.

STUDENT UNITED WAY

Student United Way is a campus-based club led by and for students, with support from its local United Way and guidance from a campus advisor to develop leadership skills, knowledge about critical community issues, and a better understanding of how they can advance the common good. Currently, this pilot program is in Auburn and we hope to start expanding to other districts in 2024.

CASH: FREE TAX PREP SERVICE

Free tax preparation services are available through the CASH Program in collaboration with Cayuga Community College who donates space and phonelines. CASH (Creating Assets, Savings, and Hope) is an in person model managed by a Site Coordinator and our IRS Certified volunteers who prepare and file taxes for community members earning \$60,000 or less.
